## **Stocks in News**

**Infosys:** The IT major has onboarded over 1.2 million users across the country on its digital reskilling program Springboard in 100 days.

**Coal India:** The state run coal miner's subsidiary Northern Coalfields Ltd is set to cross its production target of 119 million tonne for the current fiscal, and an aim of making a capital expenditure of Rs 1,640 crore remains on track.

**HCL Technologies:** The home grown IT major announced opening of a centre of excellence in collaboration with IBM to jointly offer network modernization technology to telecom companies.

**Tata Motors:** The home grown auto major said it has commenced bookings for the Altroz DCA, the dual-clutch automatic version of the premium hatchback.

**NMDC:** The state-owned miner has posted a 26 per cent jump in its iron ore output to 37.18 million tonnes (MT) during April-February period of 2021-22.

**Tantia Constructions:** The construction player has bagged a Rs 42.2 crore contract from South Eastern Railway for the construction of a major bridge between Basta and Rupsa.

**ABB India:** The company sold one of its business divisions.

**UPL:** UPL has approved a buyback of equity shares worth ₹1100 crores.

**Vedanta:** Vedanta's board has approved a third interim dividend of ₹13 per share.
