Telecom companies :

- Reliance Jio added 29 lakh new subscribers in July taking its total subscriber count to 41.60 crores. Jio now has a 36.23% market share in the wireless telecom segment.
- Airtel added 5,13 lakh subscribers during the month. Its total subscribers now stand at 36.35 crore which gives it a market share of 31.66%.
- Meanwhile, Vi continued losing subscribers. Around 15 lakh subscribers left the company's service, taking its market share to 22.22%

Tamilnad Mercantile Bank : Tamilnad Mercantile Bank made its listing debut on Sept 15. It opened at Rs 495 on NSE, a 3% discount as compared to its IPO issue price.

Tata Power : Tata Power Solar Systems has received a contract worth Rs 612 crore to set up a 100 MW ground mounted project for SJVN in Gujarat. Tata Power Solar Systems is a subsidiary of Tata Power.

IndusInd Bank : Indusind Bank has approved the reappointment of Sumant Kathpalia as the CEO for 3 more years.

UPL : UPL and CleanMax Enviro Energy Solutions will set up a hybrid solar wind energy power plant in Gujarat.

Adani Ports : HDC Bulk Terminal has signed a concession agreement with Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata, for the mechanization of Berth no. 2 at Haldia port. HDC Bulk Terminal is a subsidiary of

Adani Ports : SBI Cards and Payment Services The company has raised Rs 500 crore by issuing bonds on a private placement basis. The tenure of the bonds is three years.

Indian Hotels Company : Indian Hotels company has signed a 129-room Vivanta hotel in Haridwar, Uttarakhand. The existing hotel will be rebranded to Vivanta post upgradation.

Ujjivan Small Finance Bank : The bank has raised Rs 475 crore by issuing over 22.6 crore shares in its Qualified Institutional Placement (QIP) issue.
